PI enables the adaptation and spread of such proven and scalable solutions through programming and technical assistance tailored to local country contexts.

Role Summary

The Regional Manager for Latin America will be a key member of the Education team, responsible for overseeing the implementation and expansion of Pl's programs in foundational education in the region. This role focuses on delivering the longer-term goals for the region, securing resources, and establishing partnerships to amplify impact. It involves a combination of program leadership, partnership building, and stakeholder engagement to ensure the effective delivery and scaling of our work.

Key Responsibilities

1. **Program Leadership & delivery**

- Design and lead scalable programs for foundational learning in partnerships with local NGOs, governments, etc.
- Collaborate with PI and other global experts to develop innovative tools, frameworks, methodologies, etc. that support programs in the region.

- Provide in-depth guidance to the regional team to ensure alignment with broader organizational goals.
- Oversee the integration of digital tools and technologies to enhance program effectiveness.

2. Organizational planning, operations & management

- Oversee the annual planning process for the Regional team in partnership with Pl's global Leadership team, aligning efforts with Pl's broader mission.
- Manage operations for the region, including financial planning, budgeting & reporting, resource allocation & staffing.

3. **Regional advocacy & representation**

- Represent PI in education forums, influencing policies and practices to prioritize foundational education programs in the region.
- Publish thought leadership pieces (e.g., white papers, op-eds) in collaboration with academic and policy experts.
- Support in building Pl's global brand by showcasing its innovative approaches and field results from Latin America.

4. Strategic Partnerships & Resource Mobilization

- Cultivate relationships with high-profile donors, philanthropic organisations, and government leaders.
- Support the Programme team in securing multi-year funding commitments to ensure sustainability and long-term impact.
- Negotiate strategic partnerships that expand Pl's reach and enhance program scalability.

5. Monitoring & Evaluation

- Partner with the PI global team to implement robust measurement frameworks to evaluate successes and document learnings from education programs in the region.
- Support PI to disseminate findings from programming in the region to influence global education discourse and practices at all levels.

6. Team Leadership & Organizational Culture

- Mentor team members and foster professional development across teams in the region.
- Drive a culture of inclusivity, innovation, and professional growth within the organisation.
- Facilitate a culture of inclusion and collaboration while balancing accountability and creativity within the regional team.

Qualifications & Experience

- Master's degree in education, leadership, or a related field.
- Native Spanish proficiency and excellent English skills. Strong Portuguese language skills are desired but not necessary.
- 7+ years of professional experience, including leadership roles in education or international development.
- Proven experience in organising and leading high-level workshops, conferences, and webinars.
- Strong public speaking, networking, and leadership skills.
- Expertise in scaling developmental programs and managing multi-stakeholder partnerships is desirable.
- Willingness to travel as needed to India, including to field locations for capacity building and engagement with the broader Pratham network
- Openness to travel and represent PI on international platforms.
